

Oral Health Screening

Your child was recently screened at school by a Registered Dental Hygienist and may benefit from free preventive dental care offered by WDG Public Health. A dental screening does not replace a full exam by a dentist or dental x-rays, which can detect cavities between the teeth. Your child should visit a dentist regularly for checkups.

If any obvious visual dental concerns were found, you would have received an **Oral Health Screening Report** with the findings and information on how to access dental care for your child. Our team is happy to answer any questions about the screening and help you complete program application forms.
