



DENTAL SCREENING AT YOUR SCHOOL

Great news! WDG Public Health is coming to your school!

WDG Public Health will provide dental screenings during the 2023-2024 school year for students in JK/SK, Grades 1, 2, 4 and 7, as well as other students as appropriate. Screenings are provided based on the Ontario Public Health Standards. If your child is in one of these grades, your child is already enrolled and no action is needed from you.

What is a dental screening?


A screening is a quick look in the mouth by a Registered Dental Hygienist. A sterilized dental mirror and protective non-latex gloves are used for each child. This screening is not meant to replace a full examination by your family dentist. Parents are notified if there is an area of concern or if an urgent dental condition is found.
